PENAL LAW REVISION (ABOLITION OF THE DEATH PENALTY FOR MURDER) LAW, 5714—1954*

1. Where a person has been convicted of murder, the Court shall impose the penalty of imprisonment for life, and only that penalty.

Penalty for murder.

2. Section 215 of the Criminal Code Ordinance, 1936, shall no longer be applied, except where a person has been convicted of murder under section 2 (f) of the Nazis and Nazi Collaborators (Punishment) Law, 5710—19501).

Cessation of application.

3. A person who has been sentenced to death before the coming into force of this Law shall be deemed to have been sentenced to imprisonment for life.
